Year 4 – Drawing – Celtic and Viking

What is Drawing?

Drawing is a form of visual art in which an artist uses instruments to mark paper or other two-dimensional surfaces. ... A drawing instrument releases a small amount of material onto a surface, leaving a visible mark.

The five basic skills include the ability to recognise edges, understand the proportion, perspective of drawing, different colour schemes and putting the thought together. Using texture, tone, shape and pattern a picture can be created.

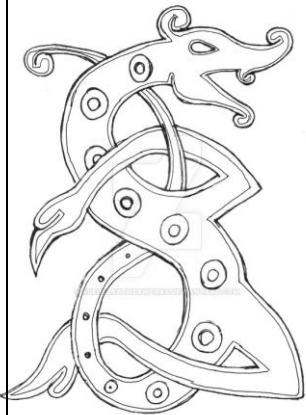
Investigate Viking dragons, Celtic Snake Knots, Viking ships.
